## Memory Peg Angels



Step 1: Collect some wooden dolly pegs. (available at your local craft shops)

Step 2: Paint the wood dolly pegs white (or a colour of your choice)



**Step 3:** Make the wings for your Memory Peg Angel out of feathers (these can be bought at your local craft shops, and can be whatever colour you choose)



**Step 4:** The arms of the Memory Peg Angel can be made from cotton buds with wool wrapped around the middle, or you can use pipe cleaners. Glue these on to your angel when ready.





**Step 5:** Make your Peg Angel a skirt. This can be easily made from an old shirt, blouse, hankie, or any other materials you have available to you. You could also choose to incorporate some clothing or possibly a scarf to remember someone by (as you can see from the images, you can make your Memory Peg Angel as unique to you as you like)



**Step 6:** Feel free to accessories your angels. You may have a favourite-coloured ribbon, charm etc, or you may want to make them a little bit festive with a sprig of Christmas tree, or placing a charm to remember someone special. You can make them completely your own.

(You can also add/glue a piece of ribbon to the back of your Memory Peg Angel, so you can either hang it on your Christmas tree, or somewhere that is special to you).
